SERVICES

Legal Services

Every month we host two free legal clinics offering access to the expertise of licensed immigration attorneys. These legal clinics provide professional, confidential consultations and services to all, regardless of their immigration status. Our attorneys speak English and Spanish and give their services at our clinic probono.

Key Services:

- Consultations on immigration, family, and criminal law queries;
- · Assistance with U.S. citizenship applications;
- Assistance with Permanent Resident Card (Green Card) renewals;
- · Guidance on obtaining family-based petitions;
- Guidance on obtaining other visas to live and work in the United States.

Irish Passport & Citizenship Services

We provide a wide range of Irish passport and citizenship services including:

- · Passport renewals;
- First-time passports;
- · Passports for minors:
- Passport cards;
- · Passport photos;
- · Assistance with emergency travel documents;
- Irish citizenship applications for eligible Irish Americans;
- Information and advice for new arrivals and those returning to Ireland.

Senior Outreach Program

In addition to providing a social and cultural outlet for seniors, the program also offers support and education on health and elder care. Genealogy Group

Second Tuesday of each month at 11 am and the final Thursday of each month at 7 pm.

This group employs the self-help method of research. Each gathering highlights a special topic of interest related to Irish history and culture as well as the following features:

- DNA studies
- Shared library of books and articles on Irish history and culture

Foróige Youth Club

Foróige is Ireland's leading youth organization. Here at the Irish Diaspora Center we have opened our doors to Foróige's first international youth club. This



youth program aims to foster a sense of Irish identity and heritage among the young people who participate. The club provides a safe place for young people (ages from 11-18 years old) to hang out and meet new friends.

We encourage volunteer leaders to help the group organize both fun and community activities. All are welcome to join and bring friends along.

Summer Immersion Program

We are proud to offer a summer immersion program to rising sophmores to seniors each summer. Our program consists of two weeks traveling in and around Ireland, meeting peers from Ireland, participating in adventure sports like surfing, kayaking, and horseback riding, and seeing the beautiful sights of Ireland that are a bit differnt than the tourist hot spots.
